



Pollution Prevention requires coordination and onsite management.

The goal is both sustainability and safety.

There are several parallels between safety supervision and construction activity pollution prevention that can make a job site and the surrounding community safer.

The following are a few examples:

- **Jobsite safety walks** for exterior construction activities
- **Trip and fall protection** during exterior groundwork and construction.
- **Prevention of exposure** to chemicals from leaks/spills

- **Dust controls** to keep particulates out of airways.
- **Air quality** associated with equipment emissions.
- **Erosion and sedimentation control**

Noise Exposure

The employer must have an annual training program for workers exposed to noise at or above an eight-hour time-weighted average of 85 decibels and follow PPE standards.
